## <u>SUFFOLK COASTAL REGION – MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT</u>

- Members at all levels have a responsibility to promote the highest standards of behaviour
- **To respect** the rights, dignity and worth of all players, officials and coaches
- To respect all genders covered In the 2004 Recognition Act
- Always co-operate with officials and listen. Do not use abusive language or be disrespectful
- **Abide** by petanque rules of SCR and Petanque England Assocations including local rules of each member club and specific rules of playing in Suffolk competitions.
- Always play well and do not directly or indirectly attempt to adversely influence an outcome
  of a game this could be interpreted as bullying or cheating neither is acceptable and
  could result in disciplinary action by the SCR and our Governing Body Petanque England, and
  possible loss of licence.
- **Be** responsible for your own actions.
- **Do not** take part or condone inappropriate or abusive language, gestures, discrimination, bullying, harassment, intimidation or violence. This will bring the SCR and/or your club into
- disrepute.
- **Do not** publicly criticise players, coaches or umpires
- Never abuse a relationship of trust, position of power at any level of authority
- Set a positive example to other players and spectators.
- . Take reasonable steps to protect your own /and others safety
- Never participate in play when under the influence of alcohol or any form of drugs
- Smoking or Vaping (e.cigarettes) are not permitted in or on the playing areas
- No alcohol allowed on or in the playing areas
- Ensure permission is sought when taking photos/videos and the necessary forms completed. These can be found on SCR website
